Guardian History



The Guardians were organized in 1963, and later incorporated in 1965, to become the Westchester Guardians Association Incorporated. In 1967, the Organization expanded to include Law Enforcement Officers from Rockland County and became known by its present name, The Westchester-Rockland Guardians Association.

The first President of the Guardians was the late, retired Lt. James A. Barrier of the Yonkers Police Department.

The Guardians formed to provide a base for minority officers to address their needs, the needs of minority communities and to have minority representation in all ranks of law enforcement. All members are expected to be productive in their departments, role models in their communities and to work to enhance conditions of all law enforcement personnel.

The Organization provides scholarships and mentoring to minority youth. Food, clothing, book and toy drives are arranged to assist seniors, local Day Care Centers, Health Facilities, Community Centers, and disadvantaged families in Westchester and Rockland Counties. Its' members engage in various community forums, focusing on topics such as Health and Wellness, Domestic Violence, and Public Safety awareness and strongly encourage recruitment, hiring and promotions of minorities in the Law Enforcement field.

The membership pledges to remain strong in their commitment to continuing the organization's mission, to remain active in their communities and provide leadership to the youth of both Westchester and Rockland Counties.

In recent years, due to the many social issues facing our country, the Guardians initiated creative ways to improve relationships within law enforcement agencies, between the various ethnic and racial groups of agency personnel, as well as improve relationships between law enforcement members and communities of color. These types of initiatives are constant as we recognize the lack of communication and understanding are underlining issues in many stressful encounters.

We thank you for your continued support which has enabled the Westchester- Rockland Guardians Association to be a viable and productive law enforcement fraternal organization who proudly serves our communities. Our members, who are all volunteers, work tirelessly to enrich lives, improve community police relationships, and increase equity and fairness in the area of law enforcement.

Historical Achievement Honorees



SGT. WALTER G. MCCLAIN JR. (Deceased)
Port Chester Police Department

Sgt. Walter G. McClain jr. was drafted in the US Army in 1942, serving as a member of the 372nd Infantry Regiment. In 1956, he joined the Port Chester Police Department, becoming the departments first black police officer hired. In 1970, he was promoted and served his last 14 years as a Sergeant. He also attended Iona College during the latter part of his career, graduating Summa Cum Laude. Walter served 28 years with the department retiring in 1984.



SGT. LARRY W. FOY (Deceased)
Pelham Police Department

Sgt. Larry W. Foy was a Veteran of the US Marine Corps. He joined the Pelham Police Department on March 1, 1967, becoming the department's first African-American hire and first African-American promoted to Sergeant on September 7, 1977. During his 20 year tenure with the Department, he was instrumental in coordinating programs for the elementary schools in Pelham, participating in the Juvenile Educational Law Project program. May 1, 1987, was named Larry W. Foy Day by the Mayor of Pelham. Sgt. Foy retired on July 17, 1987.



LT. AUBREY J. MASON JR. (Deceased)
Tarrytown Police Department

Lt. Aubrey J. Mason was a Veteran of the US Air Force. He was an Airman First Class serving in Seoul and Korea during the Korean War. He received the Korean Service Medal, United Nations Service Medal, the National Defense Service Medal and Good Conduct Medal. After the Air Force, he joined the Tarrytown Police Department, serving 20 years. He began as a patrolman, rose to the rank of Sergeant and retired as the Departments first African American Police Lieutenant.



DEPUTY COMMISSIONER ALEX S. TOONE (Deceased)
New Rochelle Police Department

Commissioner Alex S. Toone joined the New Rochelle Police Department as a Patrol Officer in 1952. He dedicated himself to his law enforcement career advancing through the ranks to become New Rochelle's first African-American Deputy Police Commissioner.



CAPTAIN DELORES JOHNSON
New Rochelle Police Department

Captain Delores Johnson joined the New Rochelle Police Department on July 11, 1965. She was promoted to Sergeant on April 25, 1974. She received the Police Commissioners Award on January 5, 1977, and the Special Citation Award on November 30, 1997. She graduated from the 114th session of the FBI Academy on September 22, 1978. On June 16, 1980, she was promoted to Lieutenant and on January 17, 1986, she was once again promoted, being the first female to become a Police Captain in Westchester County. Captain Johnson retired on May 7, 1988, serving over 22 years with the New Rochelle Police Department.



DETECTIVE RITA GROSS- NELSON (Deceased)
Yonkers Police Department

Det. Gross-Nelson Joined the Yonkers Police Department as a Parking Enforcement Officer in 1963, and in 1964 was appointed the departments first permanent African American Female Police Officer. It would be 18 years later before another female Officer was hired. She was appointed the first Female Detective serving in the Community Relations Division. She was one of the first female Officers in NY State to be on foot patrol around the clock. After 23 years of service, she retired to become the first African American Director of Security for the Hudson River Museum. She was the first female member of the Westchester –Rockland Guardians and served as Secretary for six years. On June 2, 2022, there was a street renamed in Yonkers in honor of Rita Gross Nelson.





CHIEF HENRY W. NORMAN *(Deceased)*
Tuckahoe Police Department

Henry W. Norman served our nation honorably during WWII with the U.S. Army Air Corp, as a crew member of the Air Transport Command, earning the rank of Staff Sergeant. In 1947, he began his trail blazing law enforcement career as the first African American Police Officer with the Tuckahoe Police Department. He rose through the ranks while earning numerous commendations and special recognition, as well as the respect and admiration of his peers and the public. On February 4, 1977, he was appointed to Chief of Police, earning the distinction of being Westchester County's first African American Police Chief. His legacy continues to inspire the whole community through his example of hard work, study, courage and determination that all things are possible.



LT. FRANK CORAM *(Deceased)*
Pleasantville Police Department

Lieutenant Coram served in the US Army from December 17, 1942 until December 27, 1945. He was hired by the Pleasantville Police Department on February 22, 1948 as a Patrolman, working his way through the ranks. He was later promoted to Sergeant on October 14, 1963 and then to Lieutenant on June 14, 1975. He retired on June 5, 1981, serving 33 honorable years with the department.



DETECTIVE HENRY HEATH *(Deceased)*
Greenburgh Police Department

Detective Henry Heath was 25 years old when hired by the Greenburgh Police Department on May of 1948. He was a Veteran of the US Army. Returning to his home Town of Greenburgh, he scored #1 on the Civil Service appointment list, becoming the first African American hired by the Town of Greenburgh. He was promoted to Detective on February 8, 1961.



LT. JIM BROOKS *(Deceased)*
Westchester County Parkway Police

Jim Brooks of New Rochelle, served 25 years with Westchester County Parkway Police as it was known prior to the merger, becoming Westchester County Police. He was appointed on March 1, 1952, and was the first African American promoted to Sergeant and Lieutenant by the Westchester County Parkway Police. He once said that his most rewarding experience was training and working with young police officer's, particularly the special summer patrol officers hired to patrol the parks.



LT. CONSTANCE J. COSBY *(Deceased)*
Rockland County Sherriff's Department

Lieutenant Constance J. Cosby started her career as a clerk with the Nyack justice court in 1969. She joined the Rockland County Sheriff's Department, serving 20 years until her retirement in 1989. Starting as a Correction Officer, she was promoted to Sgt. and eventually retired as a Lieutenant. Lieutenant Cosby was the first female Lieutenant and highest ranking female Law Enforcement Officer in Rockland County upon her retirement.



CHIEF HOWARD L. MCCOY JR. *(Deceased)*
Mt. Vernon Police Department

Chief Howard L. McCoy was the first African-American from Mount Vernon to join the United States Marine Corps. He was assigned to the 51st Defense Battalion, the Seacoast Artillery Gun Crew which broke a 14 year old Marine Corp record firing the 155mm at Onslow Beach. The 51st was the first all-black Marine outfit to serve overseas. They were stationed on the Ellice Islands and the Marshall Islands. In December 1945, he was honorably discharged. Chief McCoy joined the Mount Vernon Police Department on January 8, 1949. He was the second black police officer in Mount Vernon. He was the first black member to rise through the ranks. He made Detective on March 1, 1952; Sergeant on February 15, 1959; Lieutenant on April 29, 1964; Captain on March 23, 1973 and was appointed Chief on January 1, 1977 by Mayor Thomas Sharpe.





Captain George D. Rooks *(Deceased)*
White Plains Police Department

A Morgan State University graduate, who played professional football with the Green Bay Packers, the Baltimore Colts and Toronto Argonauts, Captain George D. Rooks joined the White Plains Police Department as a patrolman in 1954. He was the first African American to be promoted to Detective Sergeant, Lieutenant and in March of 1975, to Captain. He served as a role model for the Youth of White Plains, devoted to helping young people. He was co-founder of the White Plains Boys and Girls Police Club and worked with the youth tackle league. During the unrest that affected the entire country and White Plains in the late 1960's, he served as a mediator diffusing many tense situations. He was cited on a number of occasions for heroism and for furthering human rights.



LT. DAVID ROBINSON *(Deceased)*
Town of Greenburgh Police Department

Lieutenant David Robinson joined the Greenburgh Police Department, and was appointed as a Police Officer, on November 1, 1950. He was later promoted to Sergeant on July 1, 1968. In 1971, he earned the rank of Lieutenant, being the first African-American ranking officer in the Town of Greenburgh Police Department. He was the Commanding Officer of Patrol at the time of his retirement.



COMMISSIONER NORWOOD E. JACKSON *(Deceased)*
Westchester County Department of Correction

Commissioner Jackson was one of Westchester County's groundbreaking criminal justice leaders. After briefly playing for the Cleveland Browns, he served fifteen years of active duty with the US Army, as an airborne ranger, serving in Vietnam. He retired as a Lieutenant Colonel, after 35 years of active and reserve service. In December of 1972, he began his career with the Westchester County Department of Correction as a cross conflicts security Warden. In 1989 he was appointed Commissioner of Corrections. He was the first African American to assume the leadership of a Westchester County Criminal Justice Agency. He was an active governing Board member of the Salvation Army and the American Jail Association. He was instrumental in Westchester's effort to address overcrowding in the jails by calling for the construction of the Department's new generation jail, which opened in 1992. To this day the Correction Facility still bears his name.



ASSOCIATE WARDEN YVONNE M. POWELL *(Deceased)*
Westchester County Department of Correction

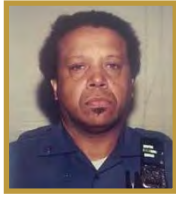
Warden Yvonne M. Powell graduated from Mercy College in Dobbs Ferry where she majored in Criminal Justice. After passing three Civil Service examinations, she decided to take a job as a meter maid in White Plains. In 1967, she accepted a position as Deputy Sheriff at the County jail. She advanced to the position of Correction Officer, Sergeant and Captain, before being made Assistant Warden. The climb was not easy. After receiving one of the top scores in the Civil Service test for Captain, she was denied the position. Ms. Powell filed a sex-discrimination case with the State Division of Human Rights and won. She was prepared to fight for her promotion during the County's appeal of the case when Andrew P. O'Rourke, was elected to the office of County Executive and reviewed the case, deciding that she was deserving of the promotion. She received wide recognition for starting many programs at the Jail, one allowing inmates who gave birth in jail to keep their babies with them instead of placing them in foster care. Warden Powell received the Westchester County Women's Hall of Fame Award in 1995. She was the first female to serve as President of the Westchester-Rockland Guardians.



LT. RICHARD DUNBAR *(Deceased)*
Orangetown Police Department

Lieutenant Dunbar graduated from Tappan Zee High School and served in the US Navy from 1962-1966. After returning home from the Navy, he joined the Orangetown Police department where he achieved the rank of Sergeant and Lieutenant, being the first African-American in the department to achieve. He retired after serving 20 years with the department. Upon retirement he was employed by the St. Thomas Aquinas College as Chief of Security and also worked as Security with the Clarkstown School District.





POLICE OFFICER COURTNEY SMITH *(Deceased)*
South Nyack Police Department

Officer Courtney Smith was the first African American Officer hired by the S. Nyack Police Department, formerly known as the S. Nyack Grandview Police Department, in 1966. Prior to his appointment, he attended Boston College and worked for the US Post Office. He retired in 1989, serving 23 years with the department. Officer Smith was a community icon, being one of the few black officers in the Nyack area and Rockland County.



POLICE OFFICER NATHANIEL L. MOORE *(Deceased)*
White Plains Police Department

Officer Nathaniel L. Moore served in the US Army from 1939 to 1945, retiring as a Staff Sergeant. After his retirement, he joined the White Plains Police Department on 11/1/45, being the departments first African American hired. He served 25 years before retiring.



DETECTIVE GEORGE MOORE *(Deceased)*
White Plains Police Department

Detective George Moore, a graduate of Morgan State University, was a decorated WWII veteran, serving in the US Army from 1942-1946. He was the first African American Police Officer hired by the City of White Plains, to be appointed to Detective. Det. Moore was also the owner of Moore Carting Company. He and Officer Nathaniel Moore were brothers.



POLICE OFFICER HELEN LITTLEBERRY
White Plains Police Department

Officer Helen Littleberry was the first African American Female to join the White Plains Police Department on January 6, 1967. She was assigned to many details, such as school crossings, Street Crime, Youth Division and Warrants, where she worked in the Detective Division for over 12 years. She retired on May 2, 1987. She received her education at Bellevue Grade School and Trinity High School in Washington, PA. She also attended John Jay College of Criminal Justice in New York, NY, Manhattan Bible Institute in New York, NY, Aenon Bible College in Indianapolis, IN, (BRE) and Brooklyn Bible College in Brooklyn NY (MTH). She is an ordained Evangelist and Assistant Pastor of True Vine of Holiness Church, located in Bridgeport, CT.



COMMISSIONER TERRANCE RAYNOR
Westchester County Department of Public Safety

Terrance Raynor- worked for the City of Mount Vernon Police Department for 22 years. During his tenure he achieved the ranks of Sergeant, Lieutenant, Captain and eventually Chief of Police. Terrance retired from the Mount Vernon Police Department as CHIEF OF POLICE, in order to accept a position with the Westchester County District Attorney's Office, as the First African American Chief Criminal Investigator in Westchester. Terrance is currently the first African American to lead the Westchester County Department of Public Safety as Commissioner/Sheriff.



CHIEF JIMMY WARREN
Sleepy Hollow Police Department

Chief Warren joined the North Tarrytown (Sleepy Hollow) Police Department in July of 1984, as a Patrol Officer. He earned a Bachelor of Arts degree in Human Resources from the State University of New York, Empire State College, in 1992. He was promoted to Sergeant in 1992, to Lieutenant in 1996, and to Chief of Police in 1998. He is a Pace University School of Law graduate, Class of 1998 and admitted to the New York State and Connecticut Bars that same year. He is a 2007 FBI National Academy graduate, 226th Session. Chief Warren retired in 2009, having served 25 years in the Sleepy Hollow Police Department.





DETECTIVE SGT. CYNTHIA J. HOOD
White Plains Police Department

Sgt. Cynthia J. Hood joined the White Plains Police Department November 17, 1986, as a patrol officer. She was the first African American female appointed to Detective and also the first African American female promoted to Sergeant. During her career she was assigned to various special details such as undercover narcotics, minority recruiting, the first female assigned to bike patrol and received an award for sharp shooting. She was appointed to Detective on December 8, 2003, and promoted to Sergeant on March 14, 2005. She retired on November 17, 2006, after 20 years of service. She has been a member of the Westchester Rockland Guardians for 35 years serving as a Past President, Secretary, Financial Secretary and current Treasurer.



ASSISTANT COMMISSIONER MONA BERRY-CAUTHEN
Westchester County Department of Probation

Assistant Commissioner Mona Berry-Cauthen earned her Bachelor of Arts Degree in Psychology from Binghamton University; and earned her Master of Arts Degree in Social Work from Hunter College. Her career was not a straight path. It included periods of working in nursing, with the homeless population, substance abuse services, and child welfare. However, the common theme in all of it was that her work and passion always involved helping and advocating for others in need. She was hired and began her career in the criminal justice field at the Westchester County Department of Probation as a Probation Officer in November 2000. Ten years later, in 2010, she was promoted to Supervising Probation Officer where she continued to work in various units with the Bureau of Criminal Operations. Standing on the shoulders of many colleagues before and during her career, she would ascend and have the privilege of serving the Westchester County Department of Probation, and the community, as the first African American Assistant Commissioner, beginning in September 2020.



SR. CRIMINAL INVESTIGATOR LATHEIA SMITH
Westchester County District Attorney's Office

Westchester County District Attorney's Office Senior Criminal Investigator Latheia Smith, is the supervising Investigator of the Westchester County District Attorney's Special Prosecutions Division. She comes with 20 years of law enforcement experience and 13 of those years have been dedicated to the Special Prosecutions Division, where she has assisted in and investigated cases related to Domestic Violence, Child Abuse, Sex Crimes and Elder Abuse.
